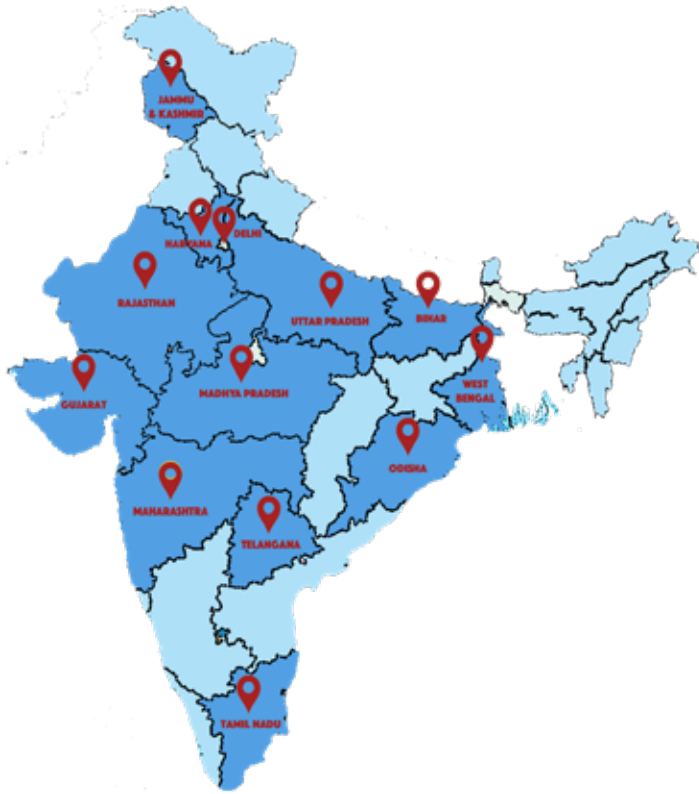

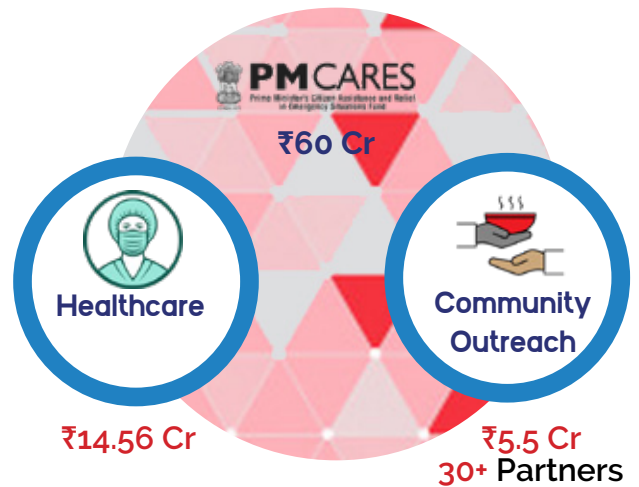

Our COVID-19 Support



The second wave has challenged our healthcare systems, caused emergency lockdowns and curfews disrupted livelihoods and education, migrants continue to face an uncertain future and vulnerable communities across India are once again enduring the most setbacks and losses.

Our guiding question has been - How can we provide support to those that need it the most? We have acted on priority to identify and support immediate to long term interventions for COVID-19 efforts, across the country for which we have made an initial commitment of INR 40 crore.

Together with our partners we have focused on providing relief and building more resilient health systems with the objective of reaching the most vulnerable and increase the preparedness for any future health crisis,

Immediate Approach

Through our community development partners, we are working across geographies supporting:

- Healthcare workers with nutritious meals
- Children in distress with response and shelter
- Vulnerable and underserved communities with essential supplies including hygiene kits

Long-Term Approach

We are focusing on long-term initiatives for strengthening health infrastructure and capacity across India

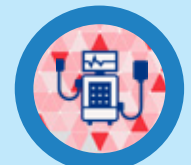
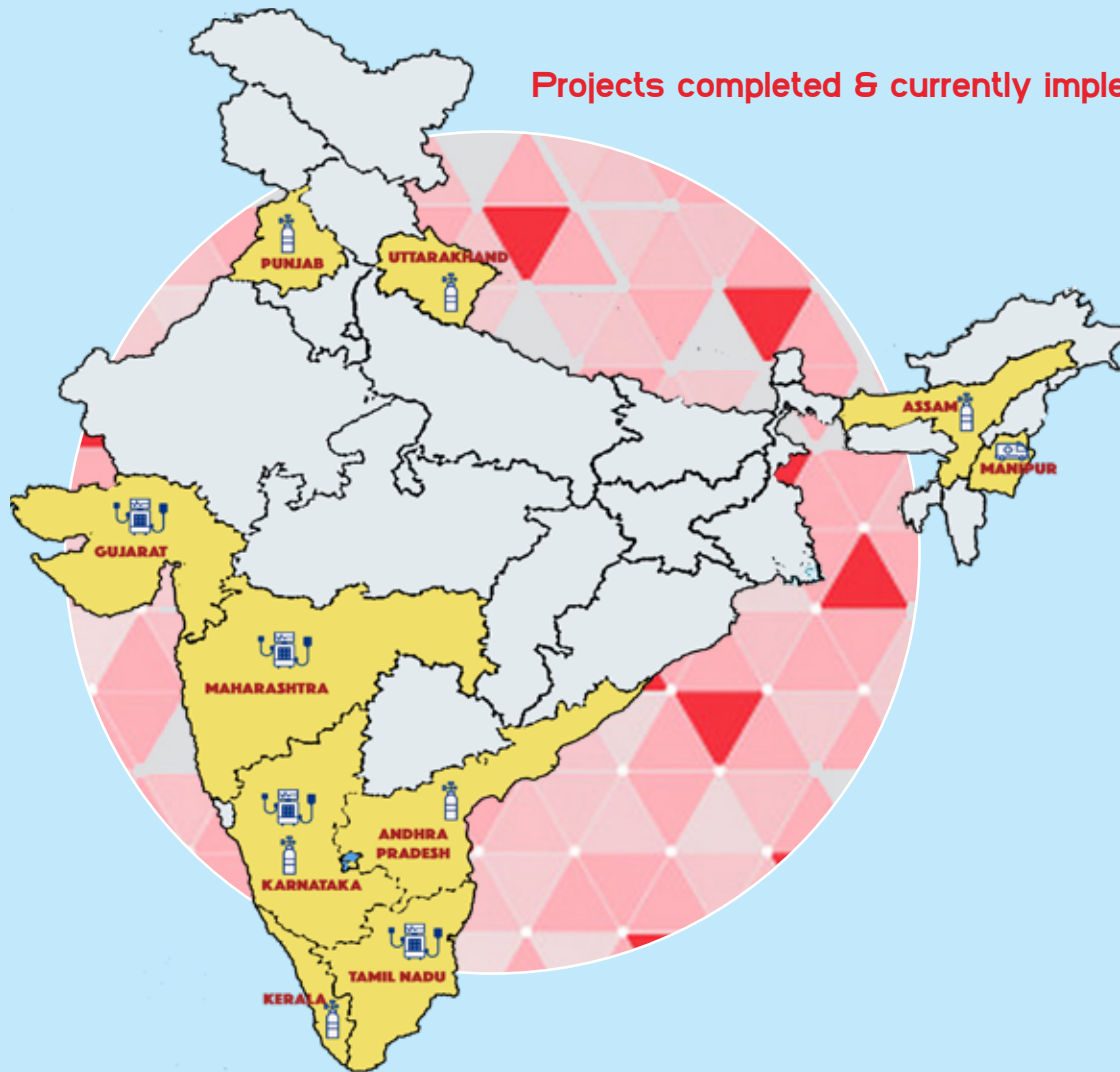
- Direct procurement and distribution of ICU Ventilators, to support critical patients
- Setting up Oxygen enrichment plants in hospitals to meet oxygen requirements in a sustainable manner
- Expanding existing hospital bed capacity
